<p><b>Call for Expression of Interest "European Heritage Awards"</b></p> <p>The Awards promote best practices related to heritage conservation, management, research, education and communication. In this way, the Awards scheme contributes to a stronger public recognition of cultural heritage as a strategic resource for Europe's society and economy. Europe's most prestigious heritage awards scheme is organised by Europa Nostra in collaboration with the European Commission and has the support of the Creative Europe programme of the European Union. There are 4 categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conservation</li> <li>• Research</li> <li>• Dedicated Service</li> <li>• Education, Training and Awareness-Raising</li> </ul> <p><b>Eligible applicants:</b> Entries may be submitted by anyone closely connected to the entry, as long as they have obtained permission from the owner of the building or site, author / owner of the study / project, or nominee, prior to submission. <p><b>Call for Applications Technische Universität Berlin - "The International Postdoc Initiative" – (IPODI)</b></p> <p>The International Postdoc Initiative (IPODI) is part of the gender equality initiative of the Technische Universität Berlin that aims to increase the number of women in leadership positions in science and research. The program addresses excellent female researchers regardless of their nationality or age and is open to applications from all fields of research represented at TU Berlin. Researchers returning from periods of international mobility, mobility between sectors, or non-academic mobility (e.g., after parental leave) are especially encouraged to apply.</p> <p><b>Eligible applicants:</b> The applicant may have no more than ten years of research experience after obtaining her doctoral degree. <p><b>Horizon 2020 "EU-Taiwan 5G collaboration" - ICT-23-2019</b></p> <p>The scope is to conduct 5G trials addressing technology and business validation of 5G end-to-end connectivity and associated management from applications in Taiwan that will support the development of mmWave, massive MIMO, new air interfaces, multi-user access and other technologies, aiming to increase the network capacity in an ultra-dense network and to provide access for a massive number of devices.
